Such was the challenge facing Cameron Glass, an Oklahoma-based manufacturer of top-quality tempered safety glass for markets that include agricultural and construction equipment, automotive, marine, vertical transportation, store fixtures, athletic equipment, and commercial refrigeration. To overcome its long-standing inefficiency, Cameron Glass began the search for a flexible, integrated accounting and manufacturing solution.

Multiple Database Issues Compromise Efficiency

“When we purchased the glass manufacturing software, we had no idea that the database was written entirely in German,” says Jimmie Cameron, CIO at Cameron Glass. “You can imagine our frustration when we tried to look up something and it wouldn’t come up, because the word was in German. Sometimes, we would have to flip through pages and pages of words in the German-to-English translation program just to find what we were looking for. To say this was inefficient is an understatement.”

In addition to the language issue, Cameron Glass utilized multiple databases that were not integrated. “Our manufacturing software did not integrate with our accounting system. Moreover, with a manual inventory system that wasn’t integrated to our other databases, inventory tracking was virtually impossible,” says Traci Kirk, sales and customer service manager at Cameron Glass. “If a customer called to check on the status of an order, the supervisor would literally have to walk the floor to locate the order. Another deficiency was our inability to tie a sales order to a work order. We had to generate work orders manually and we couldn’t see the status of work in process. The lack of integration also made it quite arduous to extract information for sales analysis and reporting.”

"Another great strength of the Sage Pro software is the open source code, which allows for modifications to be made to our exact specifications," said Cameron. "If we need to perform any modifications to the core program, it can be accomplished quickly and affordably. Source code access also enables easy integration to third-party add-ons such as the Physical Inventory and Bar Pro modules from American Computing Systems. Without access to the source code, we would have had to spend many thousands of dollars in order to make the modifications and integration we needed."
